For the location where you want to start your business, at least three legal jurisdictions will apply:


- 1. Federal, because it's located in the United States

<sup>\*</sup>For federally-recognized Tribal Nations, federal law applies on tribal lands, but not state or county rules. Instead, the LCB is authorized to negotiate **Cannabis Compacts** with Federally-recognized tribes in Washington. If executed, a Compact sets forth the rules concerning the commercial production, processing, and sale of cannabis for a Tribal Nation within Washington. You can find out if a Compact has been executed for a given Tribal Nation by contacting the LCB Public Records Office.
